VV Council gets ready to place parks and rec renewal levy on ballot

Valley View Village Council passed an ordinance at its Feb. 5 regular council meeting that is the first step to placing a renewal tax levy for parks and recreational services on the Nov. 6 ballot.

Cuyahoga County has estimated the 2.3-mill levy would generate \$370,000, according to Todd Von Ville, director of recreation for the Village of Valley View. The village uses the levy funds for park projects and maintenance. Recent projects include new dug-outs at the baseball fields, upgrades to park pavilions and restroom construction at the soccer field.

The maintenance portion of the levy provides for the wages of the groundskeepers division of the service department for the hours those employees work in the parks, including their equipment and materials, Von Ville said. The levy also funds youth athletics programs, including soccer, cheerleading, baseball, softball, flag football and basketball. Valley View does not charge its residents a fee to register for youth sports or any fees for equipment, uniforms, league dues, etc. The levy supplies the funds for these expenses.

Additionally, council approved widening Cloverleaf Parkway as part of an overall project to widen and reconfigure the parkway's intersection at Granger Road to accommodate new businesses coming into the business park, Engineer Todd Sciano said.

Council also authorized Sciano to advertise for bids for the reconstruction of

Longspur Court. This is a pavement rehabilitation project included in the village's capital plan that provides for full reconstruction of the street in the Strathmore subdivision. The estimated cost is \$550,000.00, according to Council Clerk-Treasurer Carol Tomasko.

Furthermore, Council authorized Sciano to prepare a contract to recover the roof at the community center. The area to be recovered is the part of the original building, which opened in 1998, Von Ville said. The project is still in the bidding stages.

"We have experienced an increase in the number of leaks over the last few years, so the plan is to go with a recover option that would provide a 30-year guarantee at a lesser cost than tearing off the existing roof and doing a full replacement," Von Ville said. "The recover option is possible because we are acting at a time when the roof is det-

Cleveland Council gives budget second reading okay

At its regular meeting March 4, Cleveland City Council approved Mayor Frank G. Jackson's \$645 million proposal for the city's 2019 operating budget, according to highlights of the meeting provided by the council.

This is council's second reading on the legislation. The budget must now remain unchanged for 15 days and then council will vote to approve it a final time. The budget must be certified to the Cuyahoga County Auditor by April 1.

Besides supporting a myriad of municipal operations, the new General Fund directs millions of dollars to demolish condemned properties, resurface streets, reduce infant mortality, hire additional safety forces and

address quality-of-life issues in city neighborhoods.

According to the highlights, council added the following to the budget:

- A \$1.8-million new code enforcement program in which community engagement specialists from neighborhood development corporations and other nonprofits visually inspect homes and offer owners information about programs and services available for repairs
- \$75,000 (in addition to \$75,000 already allocated) to each of the 17 council wards to help senior citizens and disabled residents with home repairs
- \$75,000 for neighborhood projects in each ward
- \$1 million for additional tree removal, stump grinding, mulch removal and tree lawn restoration
- \$375,000 to boost the city's vacant lot-cutting program

Also at the meeting, council unanimously passed a resolution urging Jackson and Eric Gordon, superintendent of the Cleveland Municipal School District, to consider a community-wide educational awareness initiative on human trafficking, according to the highlights.

Additionally, council unanimously passed a resolution calling on the Ohio legislature to increase state support for public transportation.

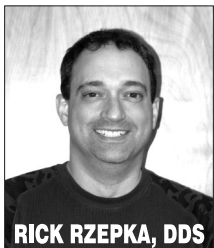

teriorating but has not done so to such a degree that the underlying materials (i.e. insulation, etc.) are in need of complete replacement. So the idea is to use this window to get the work completed at today's prices and hopefully not need to incur additional expenses with the exception of routine maintenance for the duration of the 30-year guarantee period."

Lastly, Garfield Heights resident Bob Sklodowski, who lives on Schreiber Road, spoke to council about a possible annexation of five Garfield Heights properties on Schreiber Road to Valley View due to fire and safety issues. Council discussed the subject about 10 years ago but did not approve it.

Valley View Mayor Jerry Piasecki said he did not see the necessity nor the distinct advantage to consider annexation of these parcels then, and his opinion has not changed now. He also said Garfield Heights Mayor Vic Collova is "not eager" to lose these parcels.

On Tuesday, Feb. 26, at about 8:30 a.m., Independence officers received a report of a shot fired at a motor vehicle near the intersection of I-77 and Rockside Road.

A female Uber driver was taking a passenger from her home on Kinsman Road to her work in Independence, according to the police report. As the lanes merged at the Rockside Road exit

from I-77 South, a small black car attempted to cut the driver off, almost hitting it.

The Uber driver and the passenger of the small black car argued, and the passenger leaned out of the car window with a silver firearm in his hand, according to the report. He fired a single shot, striking the windshield but not penetrating it. The vehicle then

drove west onto Rockside Road toward Seven Hills.

Officers were unable to locate the projectile and/or shell casing, according to the report. Both the Uber driver and her passenger agreed the incident was due to road rage.

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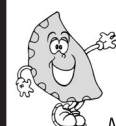

Marc's purse snatcher sentenced to year in prison

A Cleveland man who stole a woman's purse in the parking lot of Marc's in Garfield Heights has been sentenced to one year in prison, according to Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court records.

The man, Nicholas Jonila, pled guilty to the robbery charge.

During the Nov. 9, 2018, incident, Jonila, 37, tried to take the woman's purse as she was walking into the store, according to the police report. Jonila pushed the victim down when he couldn't get her purse off her shoulder and dragged her until he was able to yank it off. He then ran away, according to the report.

A witness provided police with Jonila's vehicle description, as well as his license plate number, according to the report. There was also security camera footage of the robbery.

Police spotted the vehicle a short time later and arrested Jonila. They recovered the purse and returned it to the victim, who said about \$50 was missing.

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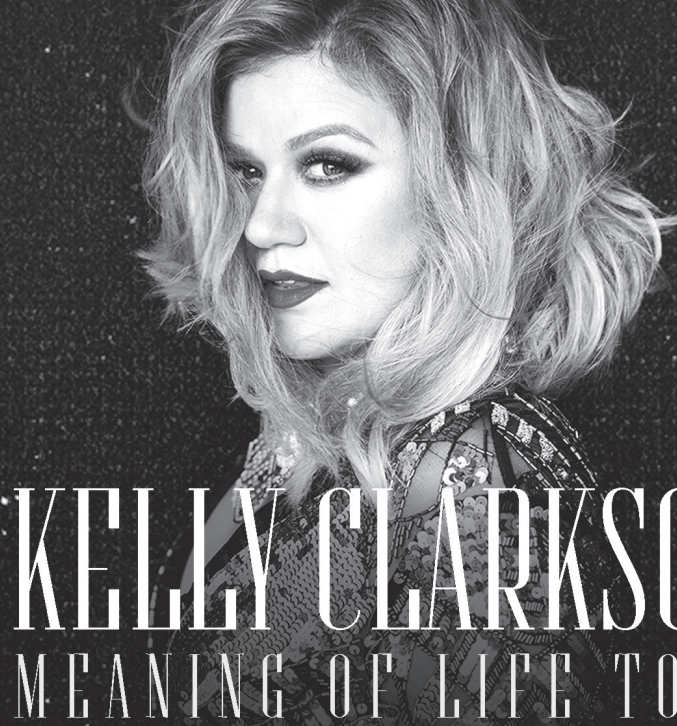
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
