Broadway McDonald's celebrates new ownership, remodeling in Slavic Village

John and Nancy House recently acquired the Broadway Ave. McDonald's restaurant in Slavic Village, along with two others on the east side, and quickly began investing in improving the building and property.

Among the improvements are digital ordering kiosks and table service, a modernized dining room with new furniture and refreshed designs, a double drive-through, Mobile Order & Pay with curbside pickup and digital drive-through menu boards.

Last Tuesday, Jan. 28, Ward 12 Councilman Tony Brancatelli, Slavic Village Development and McDonald's officials hosted a public celebration at McDonald's to congratulate John and Nancy on their investment. The restaurant is located at an important intersection at Broadway Ave. and E. 59 St., across the street from the Morgana Run Trailhead, the new O'Reilly's Auto Parts and new Oak Street Health, both currently under construction.

"As a McDonald's franchisee, there's more to the business than selling hamburgers and fries. It's about creating a lasting impact in the local community," said John House, owner/operator of 13 McDonald's restaurants in the Northeast Ohio area. "Investing in Cleveland allows us to provide job opportunities for residents and add to the city's business infrastructure."

Councilman Brancatelli commented, "We are excited that the House family purchased this location and invested nearly a million dollars to modernize the restaurant, offer new choices and other amenities. These upgrades will result in 20 additional jobs as well as a more attractive building with enhanced landscaping and appearance in our community."

County awards grants for at-risk youth; two based in Slavic Village

The Cuyahoga County Department of Public Safety and Justice Services is awarding \$110,000 in grant funding to three local organizations, including two headquartered on Broadway Ave. in Slavic Village: the Boys and Girls Club of Cleveland and Golden Ciphers Youth Development Program.

The City of Euclid Police Department is the third grant recipient. The awards are made through the Ohio Department of Youth Services Juvenile Justice Delinquency and Prevention Block Grant. The funding will support diversion programs designed to support at-risk youth through mentoring, life-skills development and employment readiness activities.

Golden Ciphers Youth Development Program will receive \$46,961 in grant funding for the SESA Rites of Passage Program.

The acronym SESA refers to "Sesa Wo Suban," a West African symbol meaning "I change or transform my life." The program is aimed at providing minority youth with life skills, mentoring and entrepreneurial and employment training. The SESA Rites of Passage Program provides youths with experience working in the Golden Ciphers administrative offices as interns, workshops on job readiness, and computer technology lessons, such as web design.

The program offers weekly group sessions after school for adolescents age 12-17 along with activities such as trips to Washington, D.C. and the annual Kwanzaa celebration for cultural learning and experience. Students who participate in the program have access to African drum making, creating T-shirts and designing jewelry. Students in the program have started their own businesses called "Golden Gifts" and "Cipher Creations."

This year, Golden Ciphers will expand its Rites of Passage Program to John Adams High School.

The Boys and Girls Club of Cleveland is receiving \$53,164 in grant funding to implement the East Tech High School Arts Based Diversion Program.

The goal of the East Tech High School Arts Based Diversion Program is to assist minority youth with the tools and resources needed to make positive life choices. The Boys and Girls Club of Northeast Ohio has partnered with Notes 4 Notes, a non-profit dedicated to providing free access to musical instruments, instruction and recording studio environments that enable at-risk youth to learn about the music industry and how music can be a creative outlet as an alternative to engaging in delinquent behavior.

The City of Euclid Police Department is receiving \$9,874 to implement the Pathway for Resilient Individuals Navigating Tomorrow (BLUE P.R.I.N.T.) Program.

BLUE P.R.I.N.T. is a new program aimed at connecting at-risk minority youth in the Euclid City School system with Euclid Police through a series of weekly discussions, events and activities, including practical hands-on life-skill lessons such as tying a tie, resume writing and completing a job application.

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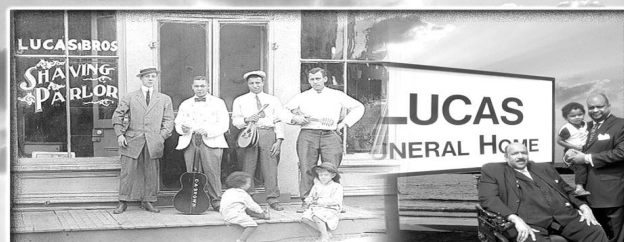

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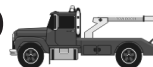

Aggravated Robbery

On Thursday, Jan. 23, about 10:30 p.m., a black male in his early 20’s, wearing a dark hooded coat and face mask, robbed the CVS store at 11223 Granger Rd. in Garfield Heights at gunpoint.

Police interviewed a store clerk who said the man had entered the store and approached the counter demanding money. The clerk, in fear of his life, grabbed an unknown amount of cash from the register and handed it over. The clerk said the robber put the money in his pockets and ran outside, at which point the clerk locked

the door and called police.

Officers reviewed video surveillance and saw the suspect walking westbound on Penfield Ave. toward E. 105 St. following the robbery. Police spoke with a witness who told them he observed a black male matching the suspect’s description enter a white Dodge Charger that was parked on the street and flee westbound on Penfield moments before officers arrived. The Detective Bureau will follow up.

Felonious Assault

• On Thursday, Jan. 23, about 11:39 p.m., shortly after the CVS store on Granger Rd. had been robbed, police were called again to CVS for a man trying to open a car door of a man waiting in the drive through. Police detained the suspect, who became combative. As a result of trying to subdue him, one of the officers sustained a broken nose and fractured facial bone. Another officer sustained a sprained knee and wrist. The suspect was finally arrested. The officers and suspect were taken to Marymount Hospital. When asked why he was combative, the suspect stated he wanted to teach the police a lesson.

Suspect charged with assault on a police officer, resisting arrest and disorderly conduct.

• On Saturday, Jan. 25, about 12:30 a.m., a police officer working at Marymount Hospital advised dispatch that a male was just dropped off at the Emergency Room with a gunshot wound. A Cleveland Clinic officer said he had spoken with the victim, who said he was walking out of Futures Bar, 4912 Turney Rd., when a man approached him and tried to rob him at gunpoint. The victim reached for the suspect’s gun and it went off, hitting the victim in the upper groin. The victim said he didn’t know who took him to the hospital and was not aware of how he got there.

• On Sunday, Jan. 26, at 2:23 a.m., officers were called to the 12600 block of Maplerow Rd. on a report that a woman had been stabbed with a knife. The victim stated she was at the Maplerow home for a party and was attempting to break up a fight between a man and a woman at the party when she was stabbed by the woman with a kitchen knife in her lower back. Police observed the home to be in disarray with broken glass and tables throughout the residence. An officer saw two kitchen knives on the kitchen floor, and one knife near the front entrance; however, no knives appeared to have blood on them. The woman suspect was held at GHPD jail for felonious assault with bond to be set by the Garfield Heights court.
