CLE bulk collection pushed back

Due to late delivery of the eight new claw trucks the City of Cleveland purchased which necessitated delayed training to operate them, bulk pick up in the city has been pushed back to the weeks of June 29th and July 6th. "We look forward to improved waste collection efforts with these new modern vehicles," said Ward 12 Councilman Tony Brancatelli.

Residents should follow regular bulk pick-up rules and put out no more than three bulk items.

Sentenced in child porn case

Devin Doran, 33, has been sentenced to three years of probation on a child pornography possession charge in the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas courtroom of Judge Nancy Margaret Russo. Doran is a former janitor at St. Michael Catholic Church in Independence.

Court records indicated he had earlier pleaded guilty to pandering sexually oriented matter involving a minor, attempted unlawful sexual conduct with a minor and importuning.

Judge Russo ordered Doran to register as a tier II sex offender. He will have to register his address with the Cuyahoga County Sheriff's Department every six months for the next 25 years.

Doran had moved out of a home he rented near St. Michael's on Sept. 3, and was fired from his janitor's job on Sept. 23, according to the Cleveland Catholic Diocese, as reported by cleveland.com.

Sentenced to prison in E. 55th & Broadway crash that killed one, injured 3 others Thanksgiving Eve

Cuyahoga County Prosecutor Michael C. O'Malley announced last week that Lennard Duncan, 41, was sentenced to up to 25½ years in prison for causing the death of a woman, 52, and injuring three others in a Thanksgiving Eve car crash last year in Cleveland.

On November 27, 2019, three vehicles were stopped at a red light at the intersection of E. 55th St. and Broadway Ave. when Duncan crashed into them. The 52-year-old victim's car collided with another victim's vehicle before going off the roadway and crashing into a metal crosswalk sign.

Cleveland Emergency Medical Services and the Cleveland Fire Department responded to the scene. The woman had to be extricated from her vehicle and was transported to the hospital, where she was pronounced deceased. The three other victims were taken to the hospital and treated for their injuries.

Duncan was taken to the hospital, treated and arrested.

The investigation conducted by Cleveland Police's Accident Investigation Unit revealed that Duncan was under the influence of PCP and THC at the time of the crash. The crash data retrieval report showed that he was speeding at 85 mph one second before impact, exceeding the posted 25 mph speed limit. Duncan's license was indefinitely suspended due to a 2010 aggravated vehicular homicide conviction. In that case, he crashed into a vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, PCP and THC, which resulted in the death of a 19-year-old man and injured two others. He was sentenced to eight years in prison and released in April 2018.

On May 20, 2020, Duncan pleaded guilty to the following charges:

- One count of aggravated vehicular homicide (with notice of prior conviction)
- One count of aggravated vehicular assault (with notice of prior conviction)
- One count of driving while under the influence

Duncan was sentenced to a range of 17 to 25½ years in prison. The Ohio Department of Corrections will review the case and Duncan's behavior after he has served 17 years and will make a determination as to whether he should be released.

Hydrant flushing in Newburgh, Maple Hts.

The Newburgh Heights Fire Department will do hydrant flushing on Thursday, June 25. Its goal this year is to flush all the hydrants in one day to minimize rusty water complaints in the village.

NHFD will post the "Hydrant Flushing Tomorrow" signs and place them on the ends of the respective streets in the afternoon the day before hydrant flushing.

On the day of flushing, NHFD will notify the service department, village hall, and Cleveland Water. Residents should keep in mind that because of weather, sometimes the posted flushing is delayed. Residents will be notified of the new date if the flushing is postponed.

Avoid running water, such as doing laundry during

flushing, and wait one or two hours until after you are sure hydrant flushing is completed for the day. The water may be discolored. Do not use hot water; run cold water from whatever faucet is closest to where the water supply enters your house, typically the basement, for about 15 minutes or until water clears up.

Maple Heights

The Maple Heights Fire Department will begin flushing fire hydrants throughout the city during the month of June. This will continue until all hydrants have been completed and may go into the month of July.

The schedule will be Monday through Friday from 9 to 11:30 a.m., and 1 to 4 p.m., weather permitting.

Cuy. Hts. Council update

The Village of Cuyahoga Heights Council met last Wednesday, June 10, and passed legislation to execute a license agreement with Cleveland Metroparks for use of properties on E. 49 St. Also passed was a resolution to execute a license agreement with CEI, Inc. (First Energy) for access over property on E. 49 St.

Both of these resolutions are related as the village has an agreement to continue maintaining the rear residential properties that abut the Metroparks property on E. 49 St.

Council also passed a change order for the Nicky Boulevard Storm Sewer Extension and Slope Stabilization Improvements Project, Phase I, and authorized the mayor to execute an agreement with Cummins Sales and Services for power generation systems maintenance services.

Finance approvals were given for the annual village grounds flowers 2020 not to exceed \$10,000, and for a Deputy Chief Test by Clancy and Associates not to exceed \$5,300.

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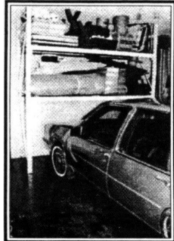

Answer – The owner or person in control of any private property shall at all times maintain the premises free of litter. Provided, however, that this section shall not prohibit the storage of litter in authorized private receptacles for collection.

Any person who violates these provisions shall be guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor. In addition to other penalties which the court may invoke, if a person is convicted of violating these provisions, the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$100 upon such person. In addition to the other penalties the court may invoke, if a person has previously been convicted of a violation of the litter law, the court shall impose a fine of not less than \$250 upon such a person for any subsequent violations. **Ordinance 114-1976.**

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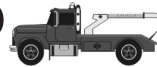

• Police responded to the 9700 block of McCracken Rd., on June 8, about 9 p.m. for several reports of shots fired. One of the witnesses told officers she saw a car parked for a few minutes on McCracken and then observed someone in the car fire several rounds at a man in green jogging pants standing in a front yard. She ran in to call police and didn't see the supposed victim when she went back outside. Another neighbor told police she saw a man in green jogging pants on top of the roof of her garage, but police were unable to locate him.

Other witnesses said an argument had taken place between a McCracken resident and unknown person(s) in the car who fired five rounds at the resident. Officers did not locate any blood in the area that could indicate a possible injury; collected spent casings.

• On June 12, about 2 a.m., police responded to the 5000 block of Henry St. for shots fired. Officers found four 9mm casings in the roadway. They checked the area and

found no suspects, victims or property struck by the gunfire.

• On June 14, shortly after midnight, police were called to the 13500 block of Thraves Ave. for a resident reporting a bullet hole in her front window which had traveled into the wall in her entryway inside the house. A neighbor said he thought he heard several gunshots about 12:10 a.m., and looked out the window and saw a dark-colored car on the street. He saw a man get into the car and drive off. The neighbor found several spent shell casings in the roadway and one live round and turned them over to police.

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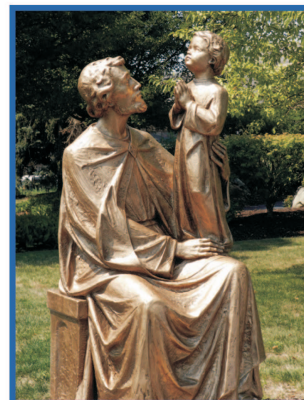
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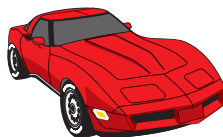
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
