## Teen shot in Garfield Hts., juvenile suspect in custody

On Sunday, April 6, around 5:20 p.m., Garfield Heights police officers were dispatched to Marymount Hospital at the Granger Rd. entrance, for a male that had been shot. Dispatch was advised that the Cleveland Clinic Police were on scene and applying pressure to the wounds.

GHPD arrived and applied life saving measures to the victim, age 16. He was then transported to MetroHealth Medical Center by Garfield Heights Fire Department personnel.

Around 7:30 p.m. Sunday, GHPD received information regarding the suspect and his location. Officers responded to a residence, and after a few hours the juvenile suspect was taken into custody.

As of Monday the victim, a resident of Garfield Heights who was entered as missing with GHPD, remained in stable condition having been shot in the neck and chest.

The juvenile suspect is being charged with attempted murder and was taken to the Juvenile Detention Center. The investigation into this matter remains ongoing. Police will not be releasing the names of the juveniles involved.

## Southgate USA shopping center up for sale

The 70-year-old Southgate USA shopping center has just gone up for sale with an asking price of over \$24 million, Planning and Development Director Geoffrey Englebrecht announced during his report at the Maple Heights Council meeting last week.

He said the city is continuing its plans to study the future of the site and the surrounding area. The 795,000-square-foot shopping center and adjacent buildings, located on about 74 acres bounded by Warrensville Center Rd. on the west, Libby Rd. on the north, Northfield Rd. on the east, and Southgate Park Blvd. on the south, has been owned by America's Realty, LLC, of Maryland, for the past 11 years, according to America's Realty's website.

The shopping center, which includes major retailers such as Home Depot, Forman Mills, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Family Dollar and Dollar Tree, has been listed for a sale price of \$28,840,000 through the Marcus & Millichap, Patton/Wiles/Fuller Group of Cleveland, according to that broker's website.

In 2024, the city of Maple Heights was awarded a professional planning services grant through the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission, Community Grant Program, to outline future development of the area, and Englebrecht gave an update on the progress of those plans.

"The Cuyahoga County Planning Commission's work is regarding the evolving of Southgate, and a redevelopment plan is wrapping up, prioritizing the future and format of Southgate," he said.

Also regarding the Southgate area, Englebrecht said that a Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative grant in the amount of \$375,000 had been awarded to the city from the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency. "It will help move part of the previous Southgate Park plan forward, with the improvements at Stafford Park," he said.

District 7 Councilwoman Edwina Agee gave an update on transportation in the Southgate area, stating, "As part of a broader effort to address an ongoing safety and maintenance concern, RTA has temporarily removed benches from Southgate's transit shelters. They are currently evaluating options for replacement seating that will ensure a safe and comfortable experience for all riders."

### City activities coming up

Englebrecht reported that the city's "Restaurant Week" is coming up, from Monday, May 12, through Friday, May 23, and 16 restaurants in Maple Heights had expressed an interest in participating this year. The restaurants will offer deals and discounts during Restaurant Week, and signs will be posted throughout the city, he said.

The city's "Music In the Park" series, with the assistance of MetroHealth and the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council, will take place in Stafford Park again this summer, Englebrecht and Mayor Annette Blackwell stated.

And through a grant from NOPEC, the city will be holding a Lawnmower Exchange Program for the second year, Englebrecht stated. Registration will take place from Wednesday, April 23, through Wednesday, May 7. There

will be a drawing for 20 DeWalt electric mowers, which residents will receive in exchange for their old gas mowers, on Monday, May 12, and the actual exchange date will be Thursday, May 15, at Maple Heights City Hall, 5353 Lee Rd.

The goal of the program, which will not come out of the city's budget, was to improve the air quality for residents of the city, especially those dealing with respiratory and other health issues, Blackwell said. Englebrecht said owner occupied-property owners can apply for the drawing, and must be current on their property taxes. The city will also have its Exterior Grant Maintenance Program again this year, with applications available at the City Hall Building Department and online at the city's website, [citymapleheights.com](http://citymapleheights.com) as of Monday, April 14. Englebrecht said homeowners may qualify to receive up to \$2500 in funding towards exterior repairs of their houses. For more information call Housing Administrator Ashley Holloway at 216-587-9026.

### Legislation on agenda

Council passed all of the resolutions on last week's agenda, including the following:

- Recognizing and observing "Black Maternal Health Week" in the city, to be known as "Healing Legacies: Strengthening Black Maternal Health Through Collective Action and Advocacy," from Friday, April 11, through Thursday, April 17.

- Authorizing Blackwell and the Human Services Department to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Natureworks Grant Program, for renovation of Stafford Park Playground, for a total project cost of \$154,365, with a local match of 25%, if granted, not to exceed \$38,591.

Blackwell said that the ODNR application was in response to legislation voted down by council in March, to hire lobbyists at a cost of \$5,000 per month to the city to try to get state funding for city projects, including updated and adaptive playground equipment.

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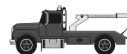
